 Elective Description: In this rotation, the student will have the opportunity to work with our
 maternal fetal medicine attendings as well as residents on the antepartum
 service. There will be opportunities to observe and participate in
 multiple areas including ultrasound, the out-patient clinic and the in-
 patient service. There will be a night call requirement. Students will be
 expected to attend the same didactic offerings that the residents attend.
 Length of Clerkship: 4 weeks
