Elective Description/ Requirements: The student will be placed in an outpatient setting to evaluate patients with eye disorders and learn different techniques of examining the eye. Techniques for eye examination will be stressed with special emphasis of diabetic retinopathy, macular degeneration, cataract and glaucoma. Viewing a series of slides will also be a part of the rotation.

1. Demonstrate and document the ability to perform and adequate eye examination; dilated fundus examination
2. Distinguish the relationship of ocular manifestations and systemic disease
3. Evaluate and diagnose common ophthalmic disorders/disease
4. Demonstrate an understanding of the common ocular manifestations of systemic disease
5. Establish treatment options of ophthalmic disease, including surgical treatment
6. Management and treatment of emergent ophthalmic disorders
7. Management and treatment of ophthalmic disease in the pediatric and adult patient
