

**The Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry at The University of Toledo** invites applications for up to four (4) one-year Visiting Assistant Professor positions. These positions, which are subject to budgetary approval, will start August 2015 and may be renewed for up to three (3) years. A Ph.D. degree in chemistry or a related discipline is preferred. Candidates with a masters' degree and past teaching experience will also be considered. The successful candidates will be expected to have a commitment to excellence in teaching at the undergraduate level in general, organic, analytical, biochemistry, inorganic or physical chemistry. Applicants should specify their field(s) of expertise. Opportunities for research collaboration with the current faculty are also possible for further professional development. The University is a comprehensive state institution in suburban Toledo with an enrollment of approximately 20,000 students. The University offers competitive salaries and an excellent package of benefits to its faculty.
