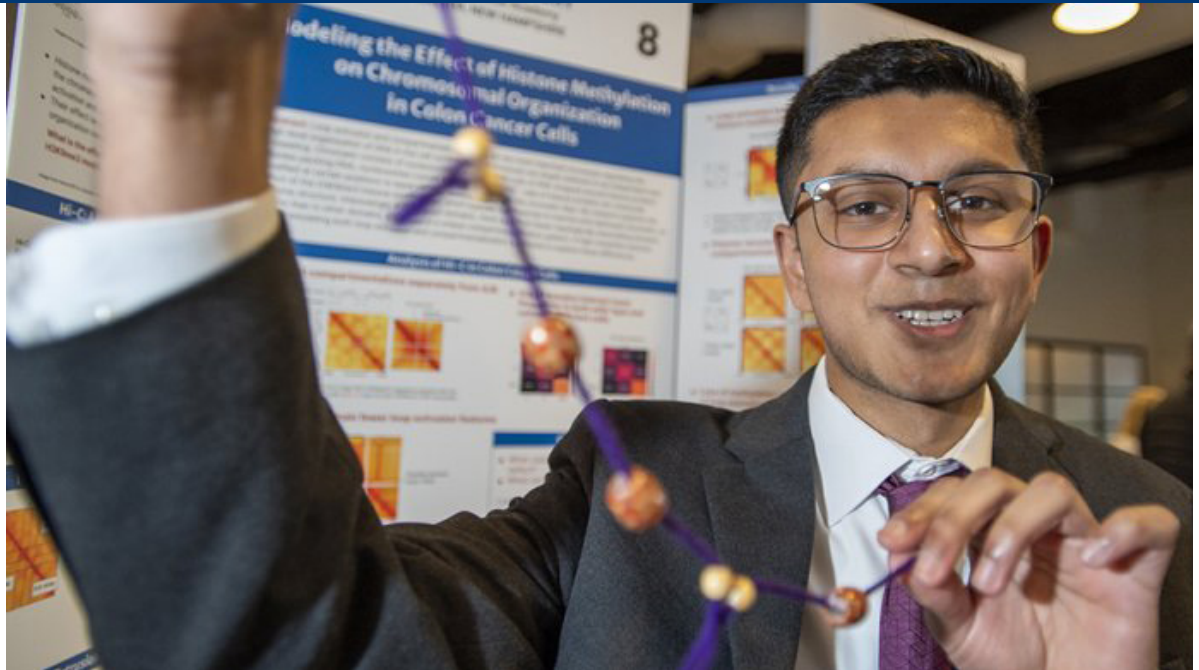


CAN CHILDREN DO MATHEMATICAL RESEARCH?
