- 1. Total fall headcount**
2. % undergraduate fall headcount
- 3. Undergraduate acceptance rate**
- 4. % of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduate students awarded Pell grants**
5. % of degree/certificate-seeking undergraduates receiving federal student loans
6. Expenditures per annual FTE
7. Total annual research expenditures
8. Undergraduate program classification focus (e.g., professions + Arts & Sciences)
9. Grants a medical degree
10. Has a hospital
11. Graduate program classification focus (e.g., comprehensive, STEM dominant)
12. Number of annual doctoral research degrees

**Bolded items are weighted heavily because they are highly correlated with retention and graduation rates.*

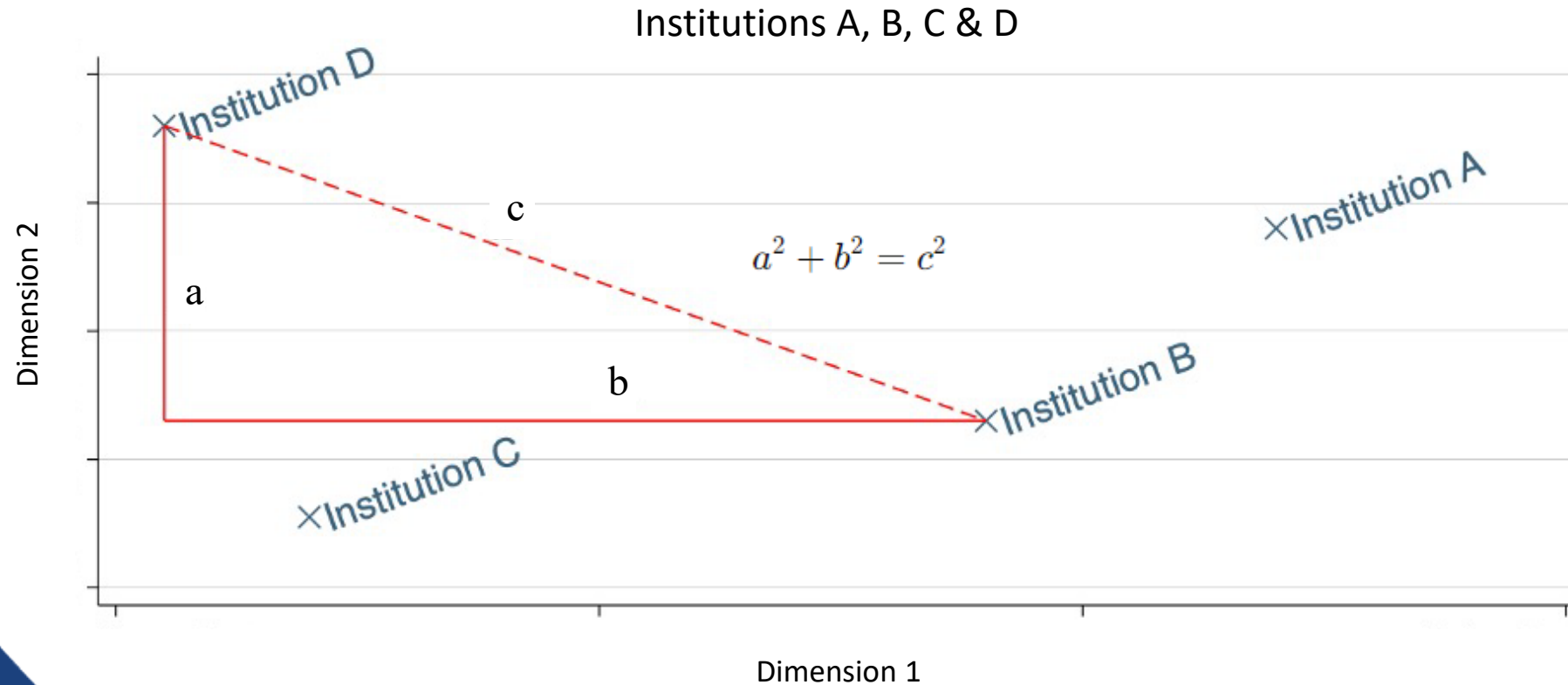
