Definitions:

ACT: Students' highest ACT composite score on record as of the term of enrollment.

Age: Age is calculated using students' age as of the first day of the term. For quality control purposes, ages of less than 10 or greater than 100 are coded as blank.

Att. Credits/ Term Attempt. Hrs : Credit Hours attempted during the term of enrollment.

Back to Med: This indicator is used to identify students who have been offered The University of Toledo's early medical school pathway program providing them the opportunity for an early interview with M.D. program following their sophomore year at UToledo.

Campus Residence: Indicates if students live on campus and in which residence halls. Data are from a combination of Banner and Star Res tables and are not available prior to 2014.

CCP: Identifies students who (a) are currently enrolled at UToledo as part of the College Credit Plus (CCP) or other high school concurrent program, (b) previously enrolled at UToledo through the CCP or other high school concurrent program, (c) previously enrolled at another college or university through the CCP or other high school concurrent program, (d) never participated in CCP or any other high school concurrent program.

College: For trending purposes, this reflects the current college of students' program, even if the program was in a different college at the time of students' enrollment.

Concentration: For trending purposes, this reflects the current concentration code, even if it was different at the time of students' enrollment.

Country of Origin: Extracted value of Nation of citizenship from BANNER [PERSON]. Also referred to as Nation of Birth in GOVERNMENT_STUDENT.

Cum. GPA: Students' cumulative GPA as of the census date.

Degree-Seeking: Indicates whether student is in a degree or certificate-seeking program. This includes Undecided students. A student is **degree-seeking** if they have been assigned an award category to the degree field in Banner. This excludes all high school students which have a student population of H but Includes students with degrees of UND except for Education Retraining majors.

Delta: Change in value from the most recent year to the number of years selected (1-year by default). Please note that the delta for percentages may differ slightly from the subtraction of two time points due to rounding.

Department: For trending purposes, this reflects the current department of students' program, even if the program was in a different department at the time of students' enrollment.

Disability: A student will have disability value **Yes** if the student has a code other than 'T' or 'Z' in saturn.sgrdisa for the current academic period.

Enrollment Status: This is defined using a Time Status of Full-Time in Banner (Source: Banner Form = SFAREGS, Banner Table = SFBETRM.SFBETRM_TMST_CODE, Banner ODS Table = ACADEMIC_STUDY.CURRENT_TIME_STATUS) and is typically defined as enrollment of 12 or more credit hours in the fall or spring term for Undergraduate, Law and Medical Students and enrollment of 9 or more credit hours for all other Graduate students. However, students taking fewer credit hours may also be considered full-time in other circumstances, such as when participating in co-ops or certain field experiences and exchange programs. This definition of full-time was adopted by the University Analytics Working Group in October of 2021. Anyone not coded as full-time, is considered part-time. IR reports published prior to that time used a credit-hour based definition of full-time, and therefore, may differ slightly from the historical data reported here.

Enrollment Type: This has one of the following values depending on the values of student type and admit type assigned to a student in Banner and whether this is their first term admitted.

- **CN - Continuing:** Students with continued enrollment at UT.
- **CR - College Readmit:** Student re-enrolling after an absence of more than two consecutive terms, excluding summer, and who has not attended another institution of higher education.
- **HC - HS Concurrent:** High School Concurrent, PSEOP, Dual Enrollment Student, TECHS student - still in high school.
- **NA - New Adult:** Student who is under age 25* and is not military/veteran, does not enroll the summer or fall following high school graduation, has no college work, and has either a high school diploma or GED, or Student who is age 25* or older and/or is military/veteran, has no college work, and has either a high school diploma or GED.
**Age is based upon the age the student will turn during the calendar year during which the first term of enrollment takes place.*
- **NF - New First Time:** For Undergraduates, a student with no college work (except while a post-secondary, concurrent or dual enrollment student) who enrolls the summer or fall after high school graduation. Also referred to as domestic DHS (Direct from High School). For Graduate students, New to UT at the level to which the student is admitted.
- **NI - New International:** New first-time direct from high school undergraduate, new first-time adult undergraduate, new transfer undergraduate, or new graduate level international student.
- **NT - New Transfer:** Transfer student whose college work was taken only after high school graduation. Does NOT include international transfer students or students whose only college work was taken during high school or the summer following high school graduation.
- **ON - Other New:** ADMISSIONS_POPULATION IS NULL AND STUDENT_POPULATION = 'N'.
- **PG - Provisional Graduate:** Student who is admitted provisionally because of missing requirements. When the student is no longer provisional, change the admit type to NP on SGASTDN.
- **TG - Transient/Special/Guest:** A Student who is attending one term; home institution is not UT or a Student who takes credit courses for personal or career enrichment and is not pursuing a degree at UT.
- **TR - Transfer Readmit:** Student who attended UT previously as an undergraduate in a degree program, has attended another regionally accredited institution, and who is returning to UT. Include International Transfer Readmit.

First Generation: First-generation college student is defined as a student with no parent or guardian who has earned a college degree as reported on the FAFSA, which underwent major revision in Academic Year 2024-2025.

Prior to 2024-2025, students were identified as first generation if neither parents' highest level of education was "college or above". Beginning 2024-2025, students are identified as first generation if they respond that neither parent "completed college", or answer that they "don't know". If students do not complete the FAFSA or leave the question blank, then their first-generation status is categorized as unknown.

First Time Status: First-Time Student (FT). A student who has no prior postsecondary experience (except as noted below) attending any institution for the first time at the undergraduate level. This includes students enrolled in academic or occupational programs. It also includes students enrolled in the Fall term who attended college for the first time in the prior summer session, and students who entered with advanced standing (college credits or recognized postsecondary credential earned before graduation from high school). Undergraduates with FIRST_YR_STATUS='FT'.

FTE (Full-Time Equivalent): The definition of FTE in this dashboard comes from the IPEDS Fall Enrollment Survey and is based on headcount, whereby $FTE = \text{total full-time student count} + 1/3 \text{ of part-time student count}$.

Greek Life/Greek Org: Identifies students who were active members of a UToledo fraternity or sorority during a given term.

Honors: Indicates whether the student is an Honor student. A student will have an attribute of 'HON' in Banner.

HS GPA: The current high school GPA on record as of the census day. The high school GPA is as it appears on students' transcript and may be weighted or unweighted depending on the school students' attended and the courses they took.

International/ Non-resident Alien: The terms International, Non-resident Alien and Foreign are used interchangeably to refer to a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States, is in the US on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely (IPEDS). In October 2021, the Institutional Research, Registrar, Student Success, CISP, and Enrollment Operations Offices agreed to identify these students as those with any Visa Type on file or a Residency code of "I" or "F". This definition is slightly different than what Institutional Research used previously. Although the impact is minimal, historical IR reports with data regarding international students as well as race/ethnicity and URM students may differ from more current reports.

Major: For trending purposes, this reflects the current major code, even if it was different at the time of students' enrollment.

Modality/Instructional Modality: Students are assigned one of the following values based on registration and instructional method of courses on census day.

- **Exclusively DL**– if all Courses for which a student is registered on census day have instructional methods of CBEO, DL or DLC.
- **Some DL**– if on census day, the student is registered for some Distance Learning courses but not all courses are Distance Learning.
- **Not Enrolled in DL**– if none of the courses the student is registered for on census day have an instructional method of CDEO, DL or DLC.

Online Admit: Any student who completed an application to be enrolled as a 100% online student, including but not limited to the following Admission Population categories:

- OH - Online Direct From High School
- OT - Online Transfer
- OA - Online Adult
- OU - Online Transfer Readmit
- OR - Online Readmit
- OI - Online International Adult
- OJ - Online International DHS
- OK - Online International Transfer
- OB - Online GR BGSU Concurrent
- OC - Online GR International
- ON - Online GR New
- OD - Online GR Non-Degree
- OP - Online GR Provisional Admit
- WQ - 100% Online Grad App
- OL - Online International Readmit

* The University began using online admission codes between Fall 2023 and Spring 2024; therefore, data for previous terms are not available.

Online Program (100% Online Program): This indicator is used to identify students who have enrolled in programs that are 100% online as indicated by a 'SMO' attribute on students' record.

Because SMO codes can be put on students' record and taken off at various times and because course modalities can be corrected after the census day, it is possible that there could be some small discrepancy between the 100% Online Program indicator and the instructional Modality indicator.

- **Current**– currently enrolled in a 100% online program.
- **Previous**– currently not enrolled in a 100% online program, but was enrolled in one before.
- **Never**– never enrolled in a 100% online program.

Pell: This indicator is used to identify students who have been awarded a Pell grant for the academic year.

Rank: Students' class rank as of census day as stored in Banner (ODSMGRACADEMIC_STUDY.STUDENT_CLASS_BOAP_DESC).

State: State of current permanent address for US students at the time of enrollment. If permanent address is not available, State of local address is displayed.

Transfer GPA: Transfer GPA as of census day for any transcripts that have been received by that point in time. Students without transfer credit will have a Blank Transfer GPA.

Tuition Residency: Residency is categorized for tuition purposes only- this might not correlate to students' actual geographical residency. In-State Resident includes Ohio residents, Monroe County residents, Forever Buckeye and Military Connected students. Out-Of-State Resident consists of all students who are not classified as In-State Resident above, including international.

Underprepared ENGLISH—based on [Ohio Remediation-free](#) standards. A student is Underprepared in English if the student does not meet or exceed the remediation-free thresholds established for Reading or Writing when entering the institution.

Underprepared MATH- based on [Ohio Remediation-free](#) standards. A student is Underprepared in Mathematics if the student does not meet or exceed the remediation-free thresholds established for Mathematics when entering the institution.

Veteran/Military Ties: If the student has an attribute starting with a 'V' on the form SGASADD then Veteran/Military Ties = Y. The student will have an attribute of either VYC, VSC or VRC for the current term in odsmgr.student_attribute.

- VYC = Veteran Yes Confirmed (Veterans, Active Duty, Reserves, & National Guard)
- VSC = Veteran Spouse Confirmed (Dependent)
- VRC = Veteran Dependent Confirmed (Dependent)

Year: Calendar year of term.
