


HISTORICAL ENROLLMENT



ENROLLMENT BY FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME




Enrollment by Course Load and Student Level (2020)











Assignable Square Feet by Major Function (Fall 2021)




Health Science Campus Map




Scott Park Campus Map
