

CLERY ACT GEOGRAPHY DEFINITIONS

On-Campus: Any building or property owned or controlled by The University of Toledo within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area and used by the University in direct support of, or in a manner related to, the University's educational purposes, including residence halls; and Any building or property that is within or reasonably contiguous to the area identified in the above paragraph that is owned by The University of Toledo but controlled by another person, frequently used by students, that supports institutional purposes

On-campus Student Residential Facility: Any student housing facility that is owned or controlled by the institution, or is located on property that is owned or controlled by the institution, and is within the reasonably contiguous geographic area that makes up campus.

Non-Campus: Any building or property owned or controlled by a student organization that is officially recognized by The University of Toledo; or Any building or property owned or controlled by The University of Toledo that is used in direct support of, or in relation to, the University's educational purposes, frequently used by students and is not within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the University.

Public Property: All public property, including thoroughfares, streets, sidewalks, and parking facilities, that is within the core campus, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the core campus.
