THE UNIVERSITY OF TOLEDO BOARD OF TRUSTEES

RESOLUTION NO. 25-04-10

RATIFICATION OF THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE UNIVERSITY OF TOLEDO AND THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME) OHIO COUNCIL 8 AND AFSCME LOCAL 2415

- WHEREAS, The Collective Bargaining Agreement between The University of Toledo and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Ohio Council 8 and AFSCME Local 2415 (AFSCME), has effective dates from July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2024; and
- WHEREAS, The University of Toledo and AFSCME have been engaged in collective bargaining under the provisions of Ohio Revised Code 4117, the State of Ohio's collective bargaining law and which has been assigned State Employment Relations Board (SERB) Case No. 2024-MED-02-0100; and
- WHEREAS, The parties negotiated a tentative agreement for a term to run from when AFSCME ratifies and the Board of Trustees approves the agreement through June 30, 2027, and AFSCME ratified the tentative agreement on March 24, 2025, and
- WHEREAS, The tentative agreement includes:

A market adjustment and a 3% increase effective upon ratification and approval to employees who are not receiving a temporary pay increase under the existing Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). In addition, eligible bargaining unit members will receive a three hundred dollar (\$300.00) lump sum not added to the base, wage, or step following ratification and approval.

A 2.5% increase on July 1, 2025, to employees not receiving a temporary pay increase under the MOU. In addition, bargaining unit employees will receive a three hundred dollar (\$300.00) lump sum not added to the base, wage, or step in July 2025.

A 2.5% across-the-board increase on July 1, 2026. In addition, bargaining unit members will receive a one hundred dollar (\$100.00) lump sum not added to the base, wage, or step in July 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

That the Board of Trustees of The University of Toledo hereby ratifies the collective bargaining agreement between The University of Toledo and AFSCME for a term commencing immediately and ending June 30, 2027.

PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY: 1626 Fairlawn Avenue

WHEREAS, The Lucas County Land Reutilization Corporation previously acquired the parcels of property (hereafter the "Property" - further depicted on "Exhibit A") located at:

1626 Fairlawn Avenue, Toledo, Ohio (Parcel No. 15-65934); and

- WHEREAS, the Property, totaling 0.0161 acres, was deemed by The University of Toledo to be of strategic importance as it would facilitate providing services and opportunities in accordance with the multiple campus master plan; and
- WHEREAS, purchase price for the Property is Five Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$500.00); and
- WHEREAS, purchase of the Property by the Board of Trustees of The University of Toledo will ultimately create the potential for expansion or other improvements benefitting The University of Toledo; and
- WHEREAS, Section 3364.04 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Board of Trustees of The University of Toledo may receive and hold in trust, for the use and benefit of the University, any grant or devise of land, and may make and enter in to all contracts and agreements necessary or incidental to the acquisition of property for the operation of The University of Toledo.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

that Board of Trustees of The University of Toledo authorizes the President, or his designee, in accordance with Section 3364.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, to conduct due diligence, to negotiate, and make and enter in to all agreements necessary or incidental to the conveyance of the Property from the Lucas County Land Reutilization Corporation to Board of Trustees of The University of Toledo. 
