CURRICULUM OVERVIEW

Core Requirements

(36-42 hours plus one natural science lab) Students must earn a C average or higher in the core curriculum.

Humanities/Fine Arts (6 hours) Select two courses from the UToledo core; no more than one course from any discipline.

Social Sciences (6 hours) Select two courses from the UT core; no more than one course from any discipline.

Natural Sciences (7 hours) Select two courses and one lab from the UT core; no more than one course from any discipline.

LAB

Core Electives (9 hours) Select 9 hours of Math, Humanities, Social Sciences and/or Natural Sciences courses from the UT core.

Multicultural Studies (6 hours) Students may satisfy both of the two multicultural requirements with approved courses that simultaneously fulfill another area of the core.

In addition to the above courses, students should select as many additional courses from math, humanities, social sciences and multicultural or natural sciences to fulfill the minimum core curriculum requirement of 36 credit hours*. Additional credit hours may be necessary to achieve the 120 credit hours required for graduation. 30 credit hours are required in the Respiratory Care major.
