# Pharm.D. Admission Pathways

- Contingent Admission (0 + 6)
- Early Admission (1 + 5)
- Traditional Admission (2 + 4)

# PharmCAS Application

- To create an account & start an application, visit [www.pharmcas.org](http://www.pharmcas.org).
- \$175 fee is due when you submit the application.
- If UToledo student, please enter Rockets email address in Contact Information section.

- **Personal Information**
- **Academic History**
- **Supporting Information**
- **Program Materials**



# Application Deadline

- **Traditional Admission pathway**
  - **March 1, 2021**
- **Contingent & Early Admission pathways**
  - **Jan. 15, 2021**
- **Must be in “Complete” status**

# Official Transcripts

- Official transcripts for every U.S. & English Canadian college/university an applicant attended must be sent directly from the institution to PharmCAS.
- PharmCAS must receive all official transcripts by the application deadline.

# Official Transcripts

- If ordering an electronic transcript (highly recommended), include your Transcript ID# at bottom of recipient (PharmCAS) address.

# Official Transcripts

- **If ordering a mailed paper transcript, submit PharmCAS Transcript ID form with transcript request to registrar/record's office.**

# International Transcripts

- Official transcripts for every international college/university an applicant attended must be sent directly from the institution to UToledo or directly from WES to PharmCAS (does not apply to UToledo students).
- PharmCAS (only if WES transcript) or UToledo must receive by application deadline.

# International Coursework

- Enter international colleges/universities attended in the *Colleges Attended* section.
- Do not enter international courses completed outside of the United States or Canada.

# Electronic Evaluations

- Requirement for Traditional Admission pathway
- Two electronic evaluations (letters of recommendation) required
- Submit evaluation requests via the Evaluations section on PharmCAS application.

# Electronic Evaluations

- Will not be accepted from relatives or UToledo CPPS faculty and staff
- Can request from professors, employers, supervisors, clergy, close family friends, & health care professionals (e.g., pharmacist, physician)
- PharmCAS must receive by March 1, 2021.

# TOEFL Requirement

- **International students, with the exception of students from English language proficiency exempt countries**
- **If UToledo student & official TOEFL iBT score report is on file at UToledo, you are not required to have it sent to PharmCAS.**

# TOEFL Requirement

- **PharmCAS code: 8246**
- **PharmCAS must receive official scores by March 1, 2021.**
- **International students, including those currently attending UToledo, should enter TOEFL iBT scores in Standardized Tests section of PharmCAS application.**

# **TOEFL *Preferred* Criteria**

- **≥ 80 TOEFL iBT score**
- **≥ 18 score in each of the four sub-categories (listening, speaking, reading & writing)**



# AP & IB Student Score Reports

- Submit Advanced Placement (AP) & International Baccalaureate (IB) student score reports (online version in PDF format will suffice) for prerequisite courses (does not apply to UToledo students).

# International Course Syllabi

- Course syllabi for prerequisite courses must be sent to [jose.trevino@utoledo.edu](mailto:jose.trevino@utoledo.edu) (does not apply to UToledo students).

# PharmCAS Fall Academic Update (AU) Window

- Dec. 15, 2020 – Feb. 15, 2021
- Submit online
- Request college/university to send official fall 2020 transcripts to PharmCAS, which must be received by Feb. 15, 2021.

# Required Prerequisite Courses

- BIOL 2170 & BIOL 2180 (Biology Lecture with Lab)
- CHEM 1230 & CHEM 1280 (General Chemistry I Lecture with Lab)
- CHEM 1240 & CHEM 1290 (General Chemistry II Lecture with Lab)
- CHEM 2410 & CHEM 2460 (Organic Chemistry I Lecture with Lab)
- CHEM 2420 & CHEM 2470 (Organic Chemistry II Lecture with Lab)



# Required Prerequisite Courses (Continued)

- **MATH 1850 (or MATH 1750 & MATH 1760 combined) (Calculus I)**
- **MATH 2640 (or MATH 2600) (Statistics for Applied Science)**
- **PHYS 1750 (or PHYS 2070 & PHYS 2080 combined, or PHYS 2130 & PHYS 2140 combined) (Introduction to Physics)**
- **PHCL 2610 (or EXSC 2560 & EXSC 2570 combined) (Introductory Physiology)**

# Required Prerequisite Courses (Continued)

- ENGL 1110 (College Composition I)
- ENGL 1130 (or ENGL 2950) (College Composition II)
  
- All prerequisite courses (or their transfer equivalents) must be completed by the end of the summer 2021 term (Aug. 6, 2021).

# Pharm.D. Interviews

- For an application to be reviewed by the admissions committee for consideration of an interview, a verified PharmCAS application & all required application materials must be submitted.
- The admissions committee conducts a holistic and thorough review of an applicant's PharmCAS application and all required application materials.

# Pharm.D. Interviews

- Interview selection is competitive.
- Interview format: Individual applicants with two interviewers



# Pharm.D. Interview Status Notification

- Applicants from other colleges/universities will receive an email with an interview status letter.
- Interview status: offered, deferred or denied

# Pharm.D. Interview Timeline

- **Nov. 20, 2020**
- **Jan. 15, 2021**
- **Feb. 19, 2021**

# Pharm.D. Rolling Admission

- November 2020 – May 2021
- Admission Status: offered provisional admission, wait listed, admission decision deferred, or denied
- Admission is provisional until successful completion of all final admission requirements.

# Pharm.D. Admission

- **If a provisional admission offer is made & accepted, an admitted applicant is required to submit a \$500 deposit (non-refundable) to hold a seat.**

# **Final Admission Requirements (if admitted)**

- **Submit PharmCAS Fall and Spring Academic Updates**
- **Complete all prerequisite courses (or their transfer equivalents)**
- **Minimum cumulative & semester GPAs for the spring 2021 and, if applicable, summer 2021 semester**

# **Final Admission Requirements (if admitted) (Continued)**

- **All health requirements must be completed & submitted by May 8, 2021.**
- **Valid Social Security number (or ITIN) by May 2021**
- **60 earned credit hours**

# Final Admission Requirements (if admitted) (Continued)

- Waitlisted students should also meet final admission requirements, in case a seat becomes available.
