Applicants will receive an email when the status is available. Applicants from other colleges/universities will receive an email with an admission status letter.
December 15, 2021 – February 15, 2022	PharmCAS Fall Academic Update Window All applicants submit the Fall Academic Update. Official transcripts for fall 2021 courses must be received by PharmCAS by February 15, 2022.
January 15, 2022	Contingent Admission and Early Admission Pathways Students with Contingent Admission or Early Admission status must submit PharmCAS application (“Complete” status) + \$175 fee + official transcripts (must be received by PharmCAS by January 15, 2022.)

June 1, 2022^^	<p>DEADLINE: PharmCAS Application + All Required Application Materials</p> <p>PharmCAS application (“Complete” status) + \$175 fee + official transcripts (must be received by PharmCAS by this deadline) + two electronic evaluations + official TOEFL iBT scores^^^ (international students) + official international transcripts^^^ (if applicable). If applicable, submit international course syllabi for prerequisite courses^^^ + AP/IB student score report for prerequisite courses^^^</p>
April 15 - June 30, 2022	<p>PharmCAS Spring Academic Update Window</p> <p>All admitted students** and waitlisted students are required to submit the Spring Academic Update. Official transcripts for spring 2022 courses must be received by PharmCAS by June 30, 2022.</p>
Spring 2022	<p>White Coat Orders</p> <p>All admitted students** will be sent an email with a link to the form to submit their white coat size.</p>
May 7, 2022	<p>Health Requirements Deadline</p> <p>ALL health requirements must be COMPLETED and SUBMITTED by all admitted students** and waitlisted students by May 7, 2022.</p>
May 2022	<p>Social Security Number Requirement</p> <p>All admitted students** and waitlisted students are required to have a Social Security number (or ITIN) by May 2022 for the pharmacy intern license application.</p>
July 8, 2022	<p>Final Admission Status</p> <p>Final admission status is available for admitted students** <u>not</u> enrolled any summer 2022 courses.</p> <p>UToledo students: Log in to https://www.utoledo.edu/pharmacy/internalapp, and click on the Final Admission Status link to view letter. Applicants will receive an email when the status is available.</p> <p>Applicants from other colleges/universities will receive an email with a final admission status letter.</p>
August 5, 2022	<p>Prerequisite Courses (or their transfer equivalents) & Summer 2022 Coursework Deadline</p> <p>Deadline for all prerequisite courses (or their transfer equivalents) required for final admission into the Pharm.D. program, as well as any other summer 2022 courses.</p>

	<p>Summer 2022 official transcripts with coursework <u>not</u> completed at UToledo must be sent directly from the colleges/universities to UToledo Enrollment Operations, AdmProcessing@UToledo.edu.</p>
<p>August 12, 2022</p>	<p>Final Admission Status</p> <p>Final admission status is available for admitted students** that completed summer 2022 courses.</p> <p>UToledo students: Log in to https://www.utoledo.edu/pharmacy/internalapp, and click on the Final Admission Status link to view letter. Applicants will receive an email when the status is available.</p> <p>Applicants from other colleges/universities will receive an email with a final admission status letter.</p>
<p>August 24-26, 2022</p>	<p>Pharm.D. Professional Division Student Orientation</p> <p>This mandatory orientation includes the Professional Advancement Ceremony. Students will receive details via email during summer 2022.</p>
<p>IMPORTANT INFORMATION:</p> <p>* Applicants will be offered an interview on a competitive measure based on a holistic and thorough review of their application and all required application materials: verified PharmCAS application, two electronic evaluations (via “Letters by Liaison” Evaluator Portal), official TOEFL iBT scores (international students; sent directly from ETS to PharmCAS), and official international transcripts (if applicable).</p> <p>** Admission is provisional until successful completion of <u>all</u> final admission requirements.</p> <p>^If a provisional admission offer is made and accepted, an admitted applicant is required to submit a \$500 deposit (non-refundable) to hold a seat.</p> <p>^^ Although the <i>application deadline is June 1, 2022</i>, due to rolling admission, prospective applicants are highly encouraged to submit a PharmCAS application and all required application materials early to ensure the application is processed, evaluated, and considered in a timely manner.</p> <p>^^^ If you are a current UToledo student and your official TOEFL iBT score report was sent directly from ETS to UToledo at the time of your admission to the University, and it is on file at UToledo, then you are <u>not</u> required to have your official score report sent to PharmCAS. International students from English language proficiency exempt countries are <u>not</u> required to submit official TOEFL iBT scores. If you are a current UToledo student, then you are <u>not</u> required to submit your official international transcripts, international course syllabi, and AP/IB student score report since they are already on file at UToledo. Applicants from other colleges/universities are required, if applicable, to have official international transcripts sent to UToledo. International course syllabi should be sent to TransferAdmission@UToledo.Edu and AP/IB student score reports (online PDF format sufficient) should be sent to meghan.schumaker@utoledo.edu.</p> <p>Throughout the application and admission process, an applicant should safe-list the following email addresses and domain:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ meghan.schumaker@utoledo.edu
