The entry-level PharmD program students will complete a bachelor of science in pharmaceutical sciences degree prior to more focused course work in pharmacotherapy and pharmaceutical care. Students in the entry-level PharmD track who have completed the bachelor of science in pharmaceutical sciences degree at UToledo and meet progression standards are eligible to continue in the PharmD program

In order to graduate with a PharmD degree, students must meet the current academic performance standards. Only students who successfully complete the PharmD degree will qualify for licensure in the practice of pharmacy. A total of 126.5 semester hours is required for graduation with the bachelor of science in pharmaceutical sciences-PharmD track degree. A total of 69 semester hours in P3 and P4 is required for graduation with the PharmD degree.
