(A) Policy statement

The University of Toledo expects students to demonstrate satisfactory academic progress towards degree completion. Academic good standing requires an undergraduate student to maintain a cumulative university of Toledo grade point average of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale. A student in academic good standing is eligible for registration for the upcoming term in accordance with current regulations and procedures outlined by the individual colleges and/or specific degree programs.

The academic progress test required for the awarding of federal financial aid may differ from the university's definition of academic good standing.

An undergraduate student must be in academic good standing to be eligible to graduate from the university.

(B) Purpose of policy

This policy defines academic good standing, and provides criteria by which students can be suspended due to poor academic performance.

(C) Scope

This academic standing policy applies to all undergraduate students enrolled at the university of Toledo.
