(A) Policy Statement

(C) Procedure

 or allied health professionals will be either sent to or electronically available for patient care and
 support areas affected by same.

- d. Information regarding practitioners granted temporary clinical privileges will be disseminated to the appropriate patient care areas upon approval. Information of an urgent nature will be <u>sent</u> <u>electronically or faxed or hand delivered</u> to any appropriate areas.
