New policy proposal

Minor/technical revision of existing policy

(A) Policy Statement

Major revision of existing policy

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Within one week of completion of a course of radiation therapy, a medical physicist will perform an end-of treatment review of the patient's radiation record.

(B) Purpose of Policy

To ensure accurate summation of accumulated dose prior to formal recording of the dosage delivered in the treatment course.

(C) Procedure

1. Therapists will schedule the patient for a "final treatment" in ARIA; which will create tasks for physicists to perform a final physics check, and the Radiation Oncologist to prepare a note outlining the treatment and completion.

Reaffirmation of existing policy

- 2. A member of the Physics Division will perform the final physics check within one week of the patient's completion or cessation of the course of therapy. If any discrepancies are noted, the Radiation Oncologist and qualified physics staff will be notified within 24 hours.
- 3. Upon completion of the check, a qualified physics staff member will review and approve the check document.
