(A) Policy statement

There will be appropriate means provided for transporting patients or staff to and from the main hospital and the Kobacker Center Inpatient Units (Kobacker Adolescent and Senior Behavioral Health).

## (B) Purpose of policy

To assure appropriate and safe methods of transporting patients to or from the Kobacker Center Inpatient Units to/from the University of Toledo Medical Center.

## (C) Procedure

- (1) All incidents/occurrences that require transport to/from Kobacker Center Inpatient Units to/from the main hospital will be assessed by the unit's Charge Nurse or House Supervisor to determine which of the following transport systems will be used.
  - (a) Walking or uUse of a wheelchair via the tunnel should be utilized in nonemergency situations. The patient will be accompanied by two (2) individuals; one of the individuals must be a licensed person. <u>This may include a social</u> worker, RN, recreational therapist, etc.
  - (b) Campus Police may be called to transport a patient by van or patrol car. This would be especially appropriate for admission to Kobacker Center Inpatient Unit from the Emergency Department and would eliminate the time-consuming process of transporting patients through the tunnel on admission, which is difficult

	and unsafe for those patients who are confused or have acute psychiatric problems.
	(c)(b) An ambulance should be used only when the circumstances of the incident require expedient emergency care which would be delayed by transport through the tunnel or when the physical status of the patient is so unstable that transport by other means presents a serious health risk.

(d)(c) Lucas County Emergency Medical Services should be used only in those rare circumstances in which a life-threatening situation exists. Kobacker Center Inpatient Unit staff will follow the directives in the Code 99 Addendum.
