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**(A) Policy statement**

Academic program review supports the mission of the institution by ensuring each academic program conducts a detailed, organized, and thorough examination of the curriculum, teaching practices, and related resources, to ensure they are meeting their objectives for positive student success outcomes. Each individual program review results in a detailed action plan based on targeted recommendations, developed to assist the academic department in their efforts to continuously improve their curricular offerings.

**(B) Purpose of policy**

The purpose of this policy is to support the systemic, ongoing formal evaluation of academic programs. The main goals of the academic program review process are; (1) to develop a valuable resource for faculty intended to enhance the quality of their curricular offerings, (2) to assist in determining the program's ability to response to future challenges and opportunities; (3) to evaluate strengths and weaknesses with respect to outcomes, resources and assessment; and (4) to determine future strategic priorities.

**(C) Scope**

This policy applies to all academic programs. The program review process focuses on continuous improvement of academic programs that have been identified for continued operation and/or investment, and reflects UToledo's commitment to supporting academic programs aligned with our mission, and responsive to community needs. Graduate programs will be reviewed in accordance with the Ohio department of education chancellor's council on graduate studies. program review
