(A) Policy Statement

The practice of noncompliant coding **shall not** be upheld at the University of Toledo Medical Center (UTMC).

(B) Purpose of Policy

To ensure our commitment to practice ethical, accurate, and consistent coding, and adherence with guidelines for Medicare Compliance and Avoidance of Medicare Fraud and Abuse.

(C) Procedure

UTMC shall adhere to Federal requirements by continuing the educational training of the coders and the coding quality review program to ensure accurate coding. Employees shall have the responsibility to adhere to coding policies in order to generate accurate codes. In compliance with Federal regulations, UTMC shall maintain a zero tolerance policy for coding fraud. Due to the potential risk and severity of Federal consequences, employees who knowingly up code/down code, and/or purposely try to defraud any insurance program shall be subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
