- 2. Patient uncooperative, combative, or unable to follow instructions.

Listed below are the general considerations for contraindications for performing a Tilt Table

- 1. Known, untreated 3 vessel disease (CAD)
- 2. Known history of sustained Ventricular Tachycardia
- 3. Moderate to severe Aortic Stenosis
- 4. Known Hypertrophic Cardiomyopathy
- 5. Current chest pain
