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## **Policy Statement**

The Electroencephalographer (EEG reader) or Neurologist on-call is to be notified immediately upon discovery that the EEG tracing shows evidence of possible status epilepticus.

## **Purpose of Procedure**

To recruit Assessment for immediate patient care in response to suspected continuous epileptiform discharge.

## **Procedure**

- 1. Detection and Reporting:
  - a. Any EEG order that states the possibility of status epilepticus should have priority attention over all other orders and be treated as a STAT situation.
  - b. EEG tracings that reveal continuous or periodic epileptiform discharges that meet the criteria established for status epilepticus shall be reported to the EEG tech on-call immediately.
  - c. Electrodes are not to be removed until the EEG can be assessed by the EEG reader for determination of the need for continuous EEG monitoring
- 2. Continuous Video Monitoring:
  - a. All EEG tracing samples performed on a given day in response to a discovery of status epilepticus shall be classified and performed as a Continuous Video Monitoring.
  - b. Technique for Continuous Video Monitoring shall be according to established policy.
