Inpatient Behavioral Health

<u>Title:</u> Dismissal from Detox Treatment

Responsibility: Department Directors/Lead Nurses/Detox Floor Nurses/Designees

<u>Purpose of Guidelines:</u> To maintain a safe and therapeutic environment, where patients can feel safe and respected while they are in vulnerable state of their recovery.

Procedure:

- 1) The Program Director/Charge Nurse/Designee may ask a patient to leave the program/ hospital for the following reasons:
 - A) Patient found with contraband after admission
 - B) Patient leaves the detox unit without permission
 - C) Patient refusal to follow unit rules
 - D) Patient refusal to participate in their own treatment
 - E) Patient is loud or disruptive to the milieu
 - F) Patient presents as a danger to self or others
 - 2) Staff will assist patient in obtaining all their belongings and arranging transportation prior to leaving, unless an unsafe situation is presented.
 - 3) If patient refuses to leave the program/hospital at that time, staff will call security to have patient escorted out of the hospital.
