(A) Policy Statement

All qualified and trained Polysomnographic Technologists are responsible for scoring cardiac events according to American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM) and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) standards.

(B) Purpose of Policy

To define the standard definition of cardiac events to be scored if they occur during a Polysomnogram (PSG) Or Titration sleep study. The Sleep Lab will score all cardiac events according to the most current version of the American Academy of Sleep Medicine (AASM) scoring recommendations, to ensure a reliable and accurate reporting.

(C) Procedure

The Sleep Lab will score arousals according to the most current version of the American Academy of Sleep Medicine scoring recommendation standards, to ensure a reliable and accurate reporting.
