## (A) Policy Statement

The University of Toledo Medical Center will admit those patients selected according to the United Network for Organ Sharing policy for distribution of deceased donor kidneys for deceased donor renal transplantation.

## (B) Purpose of Policy

To ensure that all patients awaiting deceased donor transplantation have equal opportunity to receive a kidney and/or pancreas according to a determined set of priorities.

## (C) Scope

This policy applies to members of the medical staff performing transplantation procedures at the University of Toledo Medical Center, UTMC Personnel and any other persons involved in the transplantation programs of the University of Toledo.

## (D) Procedure

- 1. When a deceased donor kidney and/or pancreas becomes available, the Organ Procurement Coordinator will identify potential recipients from the patient waiting list.
- 2. When a potential deceased donor is identified, the Organ Procurement Coordinator or Buckeye Transplant Services on call Transplant Coordinator will contact the transplant surgeon who then evaluates the criteria and decides on suitability of the organ for the potential recipient(s).
- 3. When a transplant surgeon decides deceased donor organs are suitable for potential recipient(s), the Buckeye Transplant Services on call Transplant Coordinator calls in designated recipient(s) for potential transplant.

4. Following application of UNOS criteria for patient selection, the patient(s) is/are screened and/or admitted upon order of the attending surgeon.
