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(A) Policy Statement

All kidney and/or pancreas transplant recipients will be under the care of a multidisciplinary team coordinated by the transplant surgeon throughout the pre-operative, operative, post-operative, and discharge phases of transplantation.

(B) Purpose of Policy

To ensure optimal care of the kidney and/or pancreas transplant recipient.

(C) Procedure

(1) The multidisciplinary team will be represented by the following disciplines:

- (a) Surgery
- (b) Nephrology/Medicine (Transplant Physician or consulting physicians)
- (c) Transplant Advanced Practice Provider (APP)
- (d) Nursing (Transplant Coordinator)
- (e) Dietary Services
- (f) Social Services
- (g) Pharmacy

- (2) All patients will be seen by the Transplant Surgery team, Transplant Nephrologists, APP or Transplant Coordinator, Dietary Services, Social Services and Pharmacy throughout hospitalization.
- (3) Each team documents their assessment, findings and care plan in the progress notes in the medical record.
- (4) The Admitting Service facilitates communication between all members of the team whenever they are unable to do simultaneous rounds and documents the multidisciplinary care planning in the medical record.
- (5) The APP/Transplant Coordinator facilitates discharge planning and education (see Policy #3364-140-07)
