

TOLEDO EXCEL STUDENT APPLICATION

TOLEDO EXCEL is a scholarship Incentive Program of The University of Toledo, serving talented students from groups traditionally underrepresented in higher education including African-, Appalachian-, Arab-, Asian-, Biracial-, Hispanic-, Native-American, and low-income (free or reduced lunch) students from the Toledo area who aspire to a university education and have ambitious career goals. Beyond the scope of providing scholarships, EXCEL promotes diversity, equity, and social justice. It is expected that TOLEDO EXCEL students will attend The University of Toledo.

The purpose of this program is to encourage scholarship, improve academic performance, and increase the cultural sensitivity of these young people in the community. TOLEDO EXCEL will identify, assist, and support promising eighth graders throughout their years in high school and college by providing them with skills for success in higher education and future careers. After successful participation in educational and cultural activities during high school, students become eligible for TOLEDO EXCEL scholarships to be used only at The University of Toledo. Scholarships offered to EXCEL students amount to the difference between the financial aid (grants) each student will be eligible to receive from federal, state, and other sources, and the cost of instructional (tuition) and the general fee.

To be considered you must: 1) Be an 8th grader attending school within the city of Toledo, 2) Have approximately a “B” grade average, 3) Have standardized test scores reflecting at least eighth grade performance, 4) Submit a two paragraph essay on “Why I Want To Go To College,” and 5) Commit yourself to getting involved in school and civic activities during high school. Parents of students participating in the TOLEDO EXCEL program are expected to be actively involved via the parent component, and supportive of the program’s purpose, goals and objectives.
