STEPS TO DECLARE YOUR MAJOR:

- You must meet GPA and other requirements for your intended college and major.
- Call your college office, specify your intended major and make an appointment to meet with advisor.
- Your new advisor will fill out a change of college form and submit to the Registrar's office.

PRE-MED TRACK*:

- Arts & Letters: Pre-med 3.0 and completion of CHEM 1090 or 1230 and MATH 1320 or higher with the grade of B.
- Engineering (Bioengineering path): 3.0 GPA and completion of CHEM 1230 and MATH 1850 with grade of B or higher.
- Health and Human Services: Pre-med concentrations available in exercise science and public health; use CHS GPA described on front.
- Natural Sciences & Mathematics: Pre-Med 3.0 and completion of CHEM 1090 or 1230 and MATH 1320 or higher with the grade of B.
- Pharmacy & Pharmaceutical Science: Pre-Med tracks in bachelor of science in pharmaceutical sciences degree, medicinal & biological chemistry or pharmacology/toxicology majors. See CPPS GPA requirements above.
